With over 110 miles of lightly traveled, curving roads, Houma offers the biker many distinctive and diverse routes from which to choose. Take off from downtown and in minutes you'll be touring the coffee-colored bayous, cypress-covered swamps and salt marshes of Houma's famous Cajun countryside.
